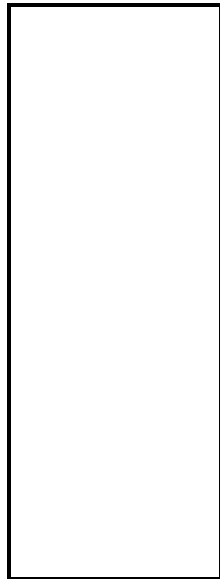

Qualification

Match event competitors must have completed a Summer Biathlon event as a Match competitor prior to Nationals. Sport event competitors must have a rifle safety/ biathlon orientation certificate to participate. There will be NO clinic held during this event. In order to be considered for the World Team or National Champion, athletes must hold USA citizenship. Sport competitors must make arrangement for their own rifle. Ammunition will be provided but there will not be club rifles available.

Awards

National Champions will be named following the conclusion of the pursuit event. Age group awards will be presented in both Sport and Match categories

Directions To Venue

From South: I81 North to Exit 15 (LaFayette). Turn right at end of ramp and go .1 mile to traffic light. Turn left onto Rt. 20E. Go 6.1 miles, turn left on Henneberry Rd. Go 2 miles and turn right onto Pratt's Falls Rd. The park is .5 miles on the left.

From North: 481 S. to Exit 2 (Jamesville). Turn left onto Jamesville Rd., 1.5 miles to traffic light. Turn left onto Rt. 173E and go 3.4 miles. Turn right onto Henneberry Road. Go 4.5 miles and turn left onto Pratt's Falls Rd. The park is .5 miles on the left.

From East or West: NYS Thruway to Exit 34A. Take I481 S. and follow the 'From North' directions above.
